Businesses open to the public may choose to allow DORA beverages in their establishment at their own discretion.

Each licensed liquor establishment within DORA decides if they wish to participate.

Establishments may choose to place a green or red DORA window decal near the entrance of the business to inform patrons whether DORA beverages are permitted.

DORA beverage purchases at one alcohol-serving establishment are not permitted to be taken into another alcohol establishment.

DORA Beverages may only be consumed from an approved DORA cup available only at participating licensed liquor-serving establishments. DORA cups are for a single use only (no refills). Alcohol may only be consumed by patrons 21 years of age and within the DORA boundaries.

Did you Know...

What rules apply in a DORA?

You can take a DORA beverage inside of a non-alcohol serving establishment that has a clearly labeled DORA sign.

You cannot take a DORA beverage purchased at one alcohol serving establishment into another alcohol serving establishment.



What rules apply in a DORA?

There will be 44 trash cans within the Piqua DORA. Cups are to be placed in a proper receptacle upon entering another establishment or when leaving the DORA boundaries.

All alcoholic beverages must be purchased from a liquor serving establishment and served in a DORA cup.



What rules apply in a DORA?

Retailers and other buildings open to the public may choose to permit or refuse to allow DORA beverages in their establishment at their own discretion.



Why establish a DORA?

A DORA allows an establishment within the DORA boundaries to essentially increase outdoor seating options to patrons.

Visitors will have the opportunity to support local businesses while also enjoying the public art, architecture and streetscape amenities found within the DORA boundaries.



Why establish a DORA?

Shoppers and visitors may be inclined to spend more time exploring downtown shops and the social and entertainment experiences often found within a DORA.

The appeal of being in a walkable and attractive downtown atmosphere may attract visitors and new residents to the community.



What are the proposed boundaries Piqua's DORA?

Piqua's proposed DORA boundaries focus on the central business district area bordered by North Street, Spring Street, Wood Street and Wayne Street, extending west on Water Street to Roosevelt Avenue.

The boundaries of Piqua's DORA will be clearly marked with signs to indicate that it is time to finish the drink and throw the cup away.
